Will you take a summer vacation? Most of us will travel somewhere to relax and have fun. Will you be a tourist, a pilgrim, or both? You might expect me to tell you to be a pilgrim and not a tourist. There's nothing wrong with simply being a tourist, taking a vacation without a specifically religious focus. So I'm not telling you to give up the water parks and beaches for Marian shrines and monasteries. Nevertheless, I encourage you to add a religious element to your vacation. Yes, go to the water park. But also search out a local cathedral or Marian shrine or place of pilgrimage. As a Catholic traveler, take the opportunity to see how others live out their faith in other places. Vacation is an especially good time to reinforce for your children the importance of going to Sunday Mass. You can instill in them a sense that vacation is never vacation from God or being Catholic. Bring God with you on vacation! Pray a rosary in the car, and if your children are young space out the five decades. Most importantly, plan ahead to attend Sunday Mass and worship the God who has blessed you with the time off from work and financial means to take a vacation. Be a tourist, but be a pilgrim too.

### WELCOME, SEMINARIAN ANDREW YOUNG

My name is Andrew Young and I am excited to be at Holy Spirit for the summer. I was born and raised in Mitchell, SD, and a proud Kernel. My parents are Donald and Barbara Young both born and raised in Mitchell. I have a sister, Amy Barr, who is a member of this parish along with her husband, Charles, and three children. I have a brother, Jay, who is married with one child and currently is serving our country in the US Navy. I am a member of Holy Family Parish in Mitchell. I was born in 1977 and graduated from Mitchell High School in 1995. I was an avid tennis player during my junior high and high school years. I attended the US Naval academy in Annapolis, Maryland, and graduated with a degree in Aerospace Engineering in 1999. Additionally, I received a commission in the US Marine Corps. My duties in the Marines took me to my home duty station at Camp Pendleton, Calif. I was deployed twice in support of military operations to Afghanistan and Iraq.
