From the Desk of the Pastor,

One implication of the Ascension which is often overlooked is the fact that we should not expect any more signs or wonders or spectacular miracles. While on earth, Jesus did many of these. Not that they couldn't happen or don't happen, but the time of revealing is ended with Christ's return to the Father. The Lord now expects us to stand on our own God-given two feet and operate in a natural world with natural insights elevated by grace. Our task now is to be faithful witnesses. We have seen the Risen Christ, continue to see Him in the Eucharist, and we believe and follow. I am reminded of this as pastor when I look around and see the many facets of parish life that make Holy Spirit the "active place of witness" that it is. We provide so much for our people, but it's important to remember our people ask for it...and they expect it. There are days when it's hard to stand on our own two feet and let nature take its course, and we do wish for some great wonder and miracle. Not to sound the alarm, but I'm feeling that way right now as I look over CFSA pledges for the year and see that we are considerably behind budget. I wish it would just fall out of the sky and then I wouldn't have to worry about it. Or like the "multiplication of the loaves," there would be the miraculous "multiplication of ordinary income" to the parish. But that's not going to happen, so I have to be realistic. If we don't receive the CFSA pledges and the weekly collections that we need to meet our budget for this year, and plan for next year's, then the reality is that programs will be cut. One thing I would suggest: I know with so many parishes and so many Mass times in Sioux Falls people "parish-hop" for a variety of different reasons that I won't get into right now. Please remember to take your HOLY SPIRIT envelope along and drop it in the basket at whatever parish you happen to find yourself at. Or drop it in the mail if you know you won't be attending Mass here. It should get back to us. I'm just trying to cover all the angles. In the meantime, I won't quit praying for miracles, but I would rather see us stand on our own two feet!

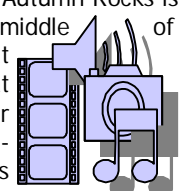

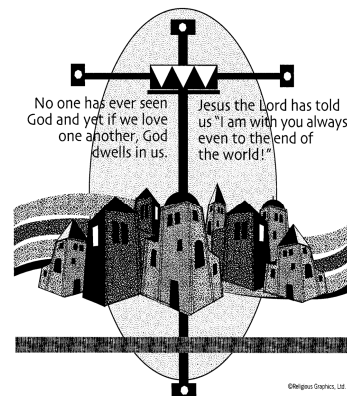
